Music Notes

- 1) Rapid Repentance (Instant response to God's conviction of sin in our lives.)
- 2) Corporate Confession (Scripture teaches this and we have seen how God blesses our obedience)
- 3) Fast Forgiveness (Delayed obedience in this area is not obedience, but sin. If we are to be free from the bondage of bitterness and un-forgiveness, if we want to be forgiven, we must forgive others.)

Additionally, we've been reminded to . . .

- Return to our First Love.
- Worship fully and wholeheartedly as prescribed in Scripture.
- Put off sin and self and Put on the characteristics of Christ.
- Follow God's Plan of Governance in the Church and in the Home.
- Live radically by living obediently to the Word of God.
- Make a family altar and personal Holy Hour a priority daily.
- Find a Spiritual Pal to help us in this walk.
- Live authentically for Christ with accountability to others and to become the Salt and Light that is needed where we live and work and go to school.

The Summit has been huge for us, but, God is doing a new thing among us and we dare not camp and grow content with what has been. *"The death of revival occurs when we become satisfied with what God has done."* Revival continues for Southside as we continually observe where God is at work and then make the adjustments in our lives to join Him.

Vance Havner said, *"Revival is the church falling in love with Jesus all over again."* (and again, and again, and again.)
